Issuance of Finding of No Significant Impact and Decision Record  
Buckskin Fuels Management Project  
EA# ID-075-2002-014

With this notice, the Bureau of Land Management announces the availability of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Decision Record for the Buckskin Fuels Management Project (EA# ID-075-2002-014).

This wildfire management decision is issued under 43 CFR Part 5003.1 and is effective immediately. The BLM has made the determination that vegetation, soil, or other resources on the public lands are at substantial risk of wildfire due to drought, fuels buildup, or other reasons, or at immediate risk of erosion or other damage due to wildfire. Thus, notwithstanding the provisions of 43 CFR 4.21(a)(1), filing a notice of appeal under 43 CFR Part 4 does not automatically suspend the effect of the decision. The Interior Board of Land Appeals must decide an appeal of this decision within 60 days after all pleadings have been filed, and within 180 days after the appeal was filed. 43 CFR 4.416.

Any party who is adversely affected by this decision has a right to appeal to the Interior Board of Land Appeals, in accordance with the provisions described in 43 CFR Part 4. A person who wishes to appeal must file a notice that he wishes to appeal with the Field Manager, Bureau of Land Management, Pocatello Field Office, 1111 North 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Pocatello, Idaho 83201, who made the decision. The notice must be filed within 30 days after publication of this notice in the *Idaho State Journal*. The notice of appeal must identify the decision being appealed, and may include a statement of reasons for and any argument the appellant wishes to make. If the notice does not include any statement of reasons for the appeal, the appellant shall file such a statement with the Interior Board of Land Appeals, Office of Hearings and Appeals, 4015 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Virginia 22203, within 30 days after the notice of appeal was filed. The appellant shall serve a copy of the notice of appeal and any statement of reasons and arguments to the Field Solicitor, U.S. Department of the Interior, Federal Building & U.S. Courthouse, 550 West Fort Street, MSC 020, Boise, Idaho 83724, not later than 15 days after filing the document. Service of the copy may be made by delivering the copy personally or by sending it by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested. Implementation of this decision may begin at the close of an appeal-filing period which ends 30 days after service of this notice in the *Idaho State Journal*.
