**Distribution:** Ada, Boise, Elmore, and Gem counties, Idaho.

**Habitat:** Steep north-facing slopes, often in snow bank areas on moss mats, big sagebrush-Idaho fescue communities and bitterbrush, from 900-1300 m elevation.


**Phenology:** March through April.

**Look-alikes:** In vegetative features confused with shooting star (*Dodecatheon* species), which grows with the *Primula*, but easily recognized in flower. Similar to if not synonymous with *P. cusickiana*. Its distinctiveness is still questionable.
