



3.9 McCulley Creek - Named after a family who ranched up the creek; 11 boys from this family served in WWII.

4.1 Big Foot Island Class II - Requires some maneuvering; can be run on either side. This is the only island on the Salmon River with an official U.S. Geological Survey name.

3.1 Lyons Bar - The dirt road that follows the river ends here. Originally planned to shorten the distance between White Bird and Cottonwood, this Works Project Administration enterprise was abandoned in 1940 due to political pressure from the town of Grangeville, which would have been bypassed. There are three large camp spots and several small ones in this area.
