8	Mammoth Cave	Lichen covered blocky lava rock used for rock walls and landscaping.	Lincoln County, north of Shoshone.	\$6.50/ton; No reclamation fee	No maximum or minimum

12	<u>Windsand</u>	Windblown sand, used for fill material, sand may only be removed from areas marked with white posts, permittees using dump trucks and front end loaders will be limited to a two day permit.	Lincoln County, between Shoshone and Gooding.	Sand - \$0.55/cubic yard Reclamation - \$0.20/cubic yard Total -\$0.75/cubic yard	Minimum -15 cubic yards Maximum -100 cubic yards/year
3	<u>Johnson Hill</u>	Rip-rap and decomposed granite used for flood control and roadbase.	Camas County, southeast of Fairfield.	\$1.00/yard; No reclamation fee	No maximum or minimum.
