Intensive monitoring has not occurred at this breeding area, and the information portrayed is preliminary only. The circle encloses the Principal Management Area (PMA). The star indicates the current nest site. Dots and numbers indicate prominent foraging perches/locations determined in 1998 observations. (Two historic alternate nests in an old heron rookery approximately 3/4 mile upriver of current nest are not shown within the PMA. The area of the historic alternates should also be managed as a part of the PMA.)
