Intensive monitoring has not occurred at this breeding area, and the information portrayed is preliminary only. The circle encloses the Principal Management Area. The three stars indicate the known nest sites, the highest and lowest of which are still intact. (The 1998 nest was the lowest star.) The numbers refer to primary foraging perches and locations. Perch 1 is 1.5 miles southeast of the photo; perch 2 is 2.2 miles to the northeast.
